This flyer was distributed by the One Nation political party to encourage supporters to join the party. The One Nation party rose to prominence in the 90s with a policy against immigration. The One Nation party gained popularity through its attempts to re-establish the protectionist policies that Australia had held in the past which claimed to protect its workers and industries. The protection of small business and the encouragement of Australian industry were major factors in the successes the party achieved during this time. The policies the One Nation party sought to promote were very similar to the political actions of the Australian Government under the White Australia policy.
